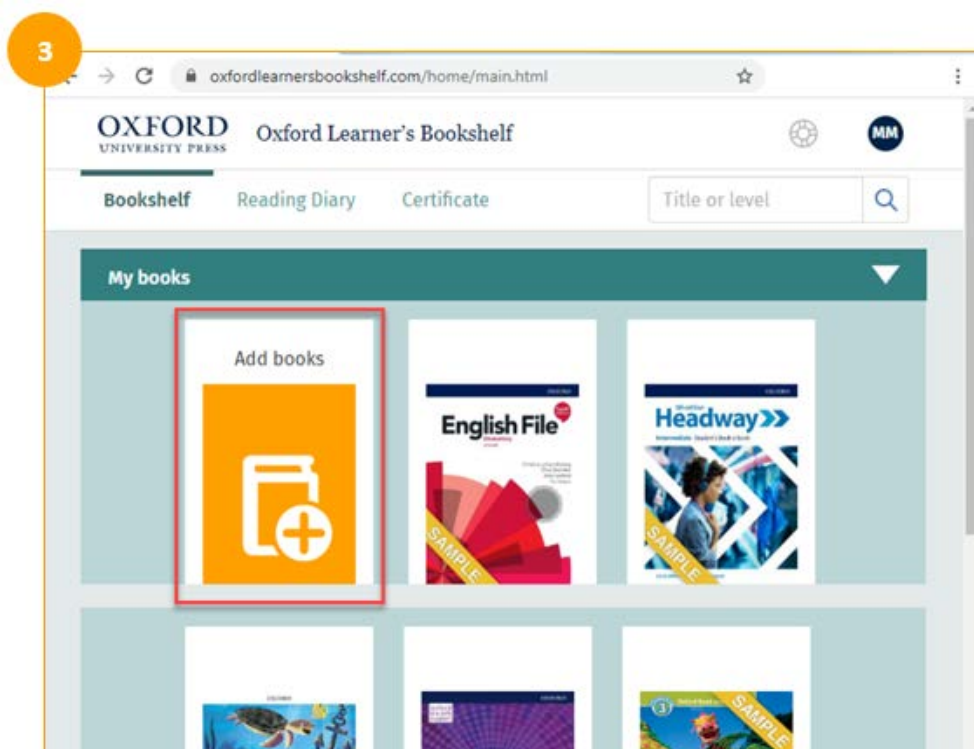

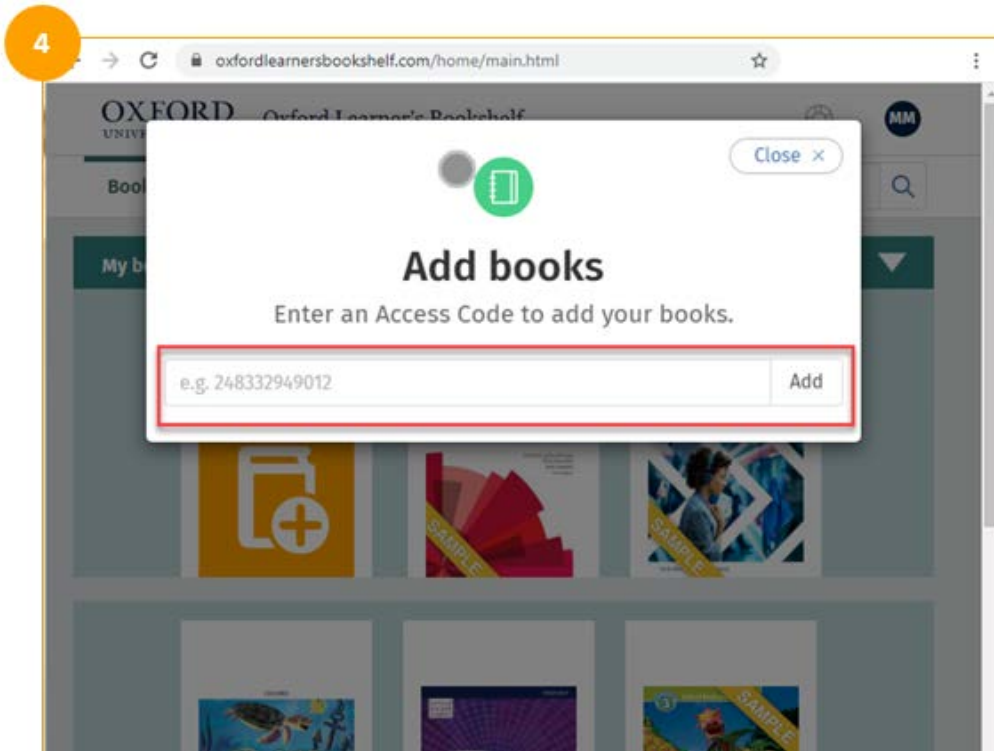

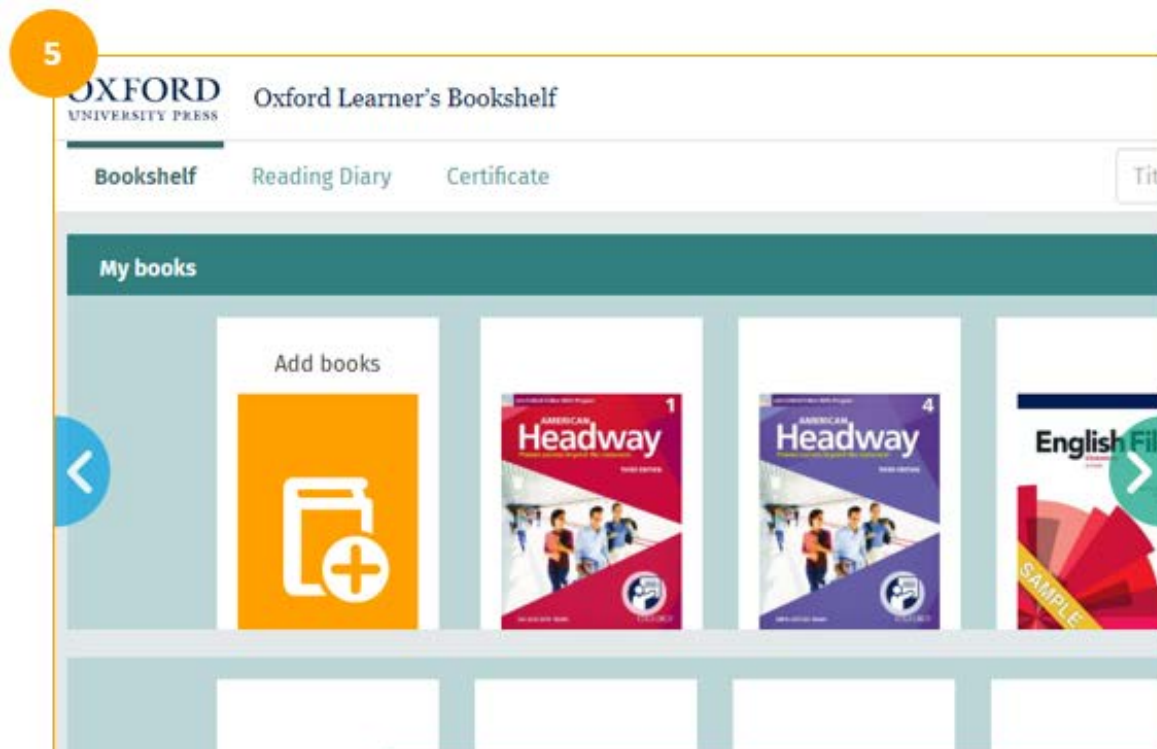


To use your Access Code, choose the **'Add books'** button.



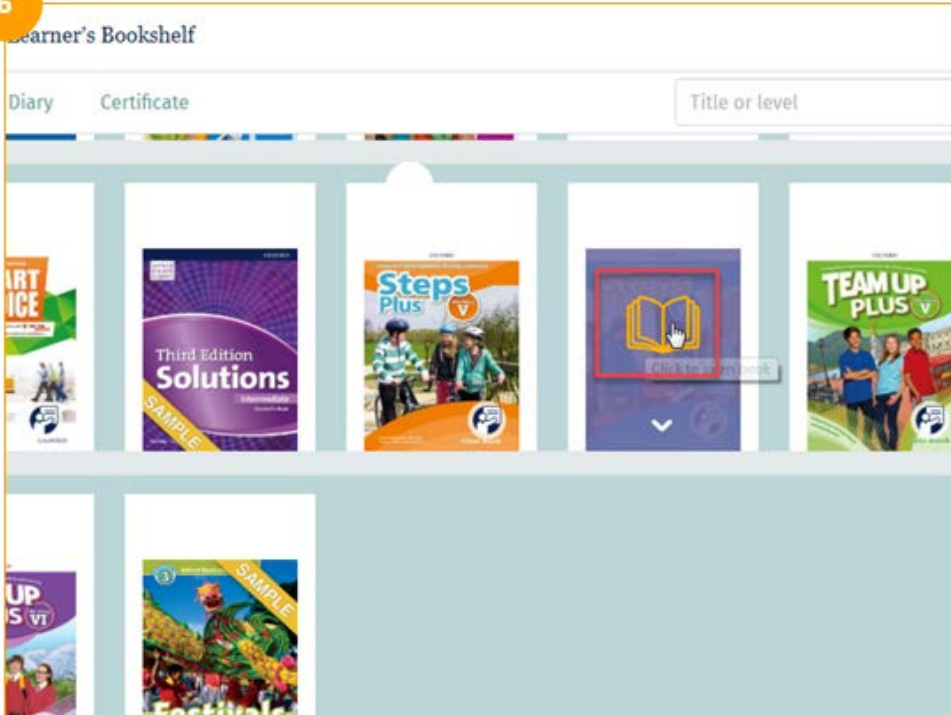
Put your Access Code in the box.

**Important!** You only need to use the code once.



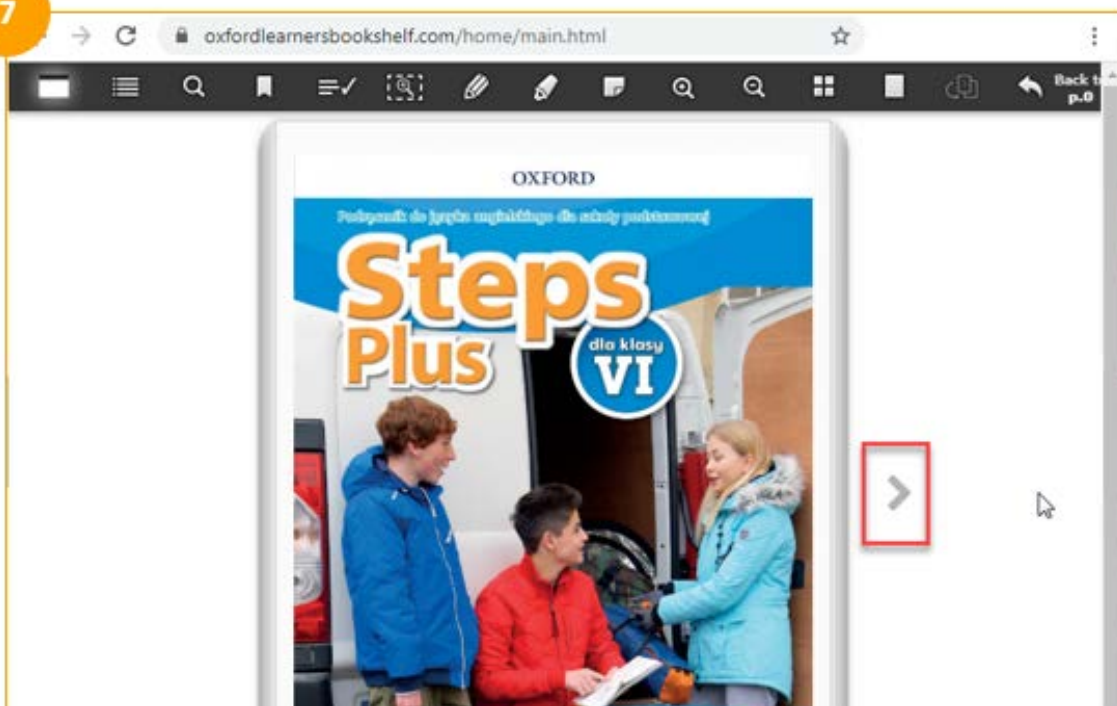
Your book is now on your bookshelf. The books are ordered by title.

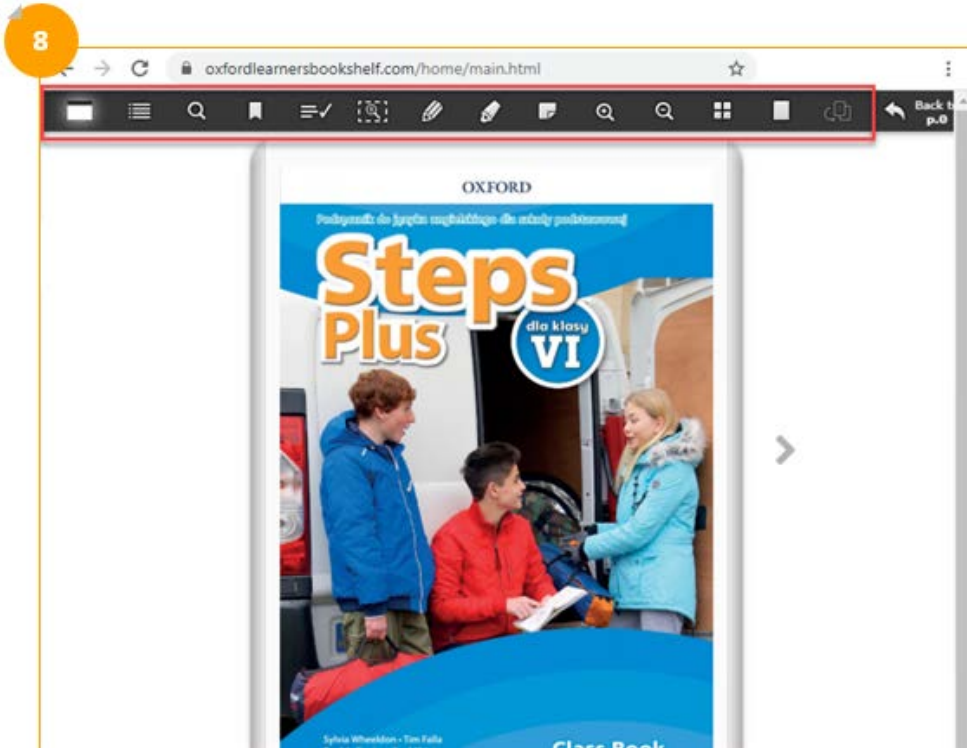


To open the book, click on its cover.

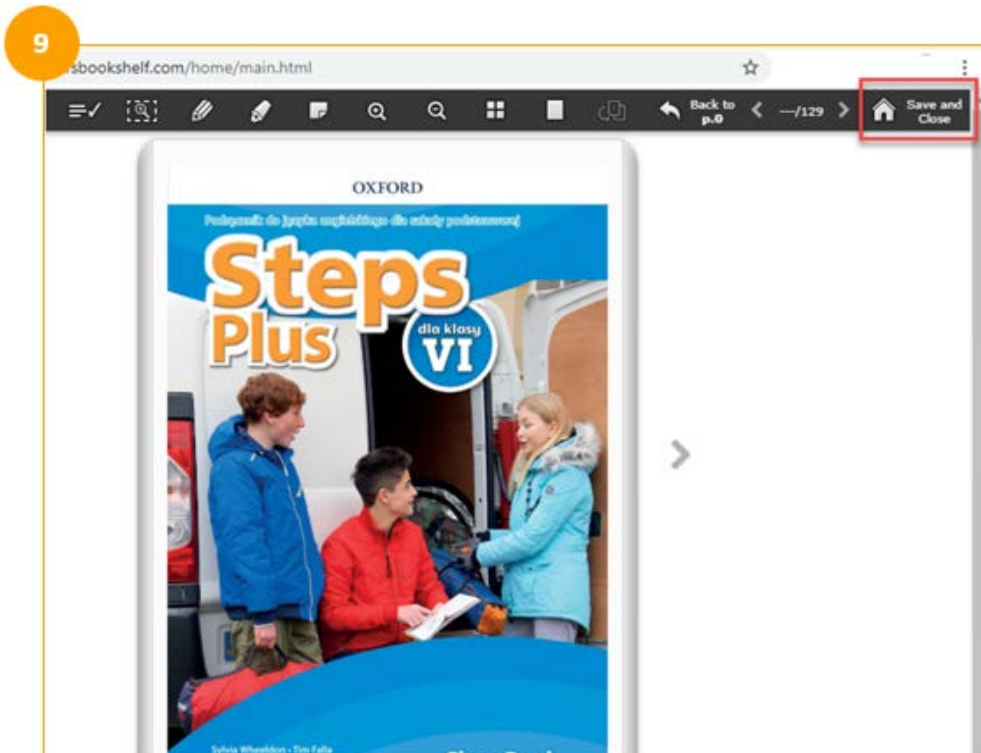

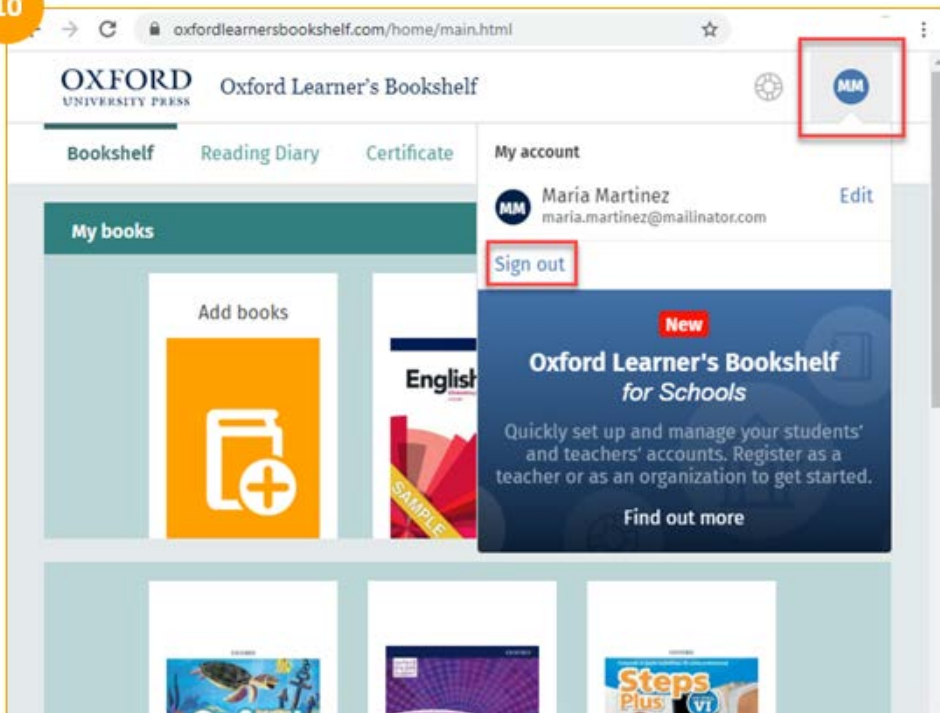
When the book opens, use arrows to turn the pages.

## Download e-books to a computer or device

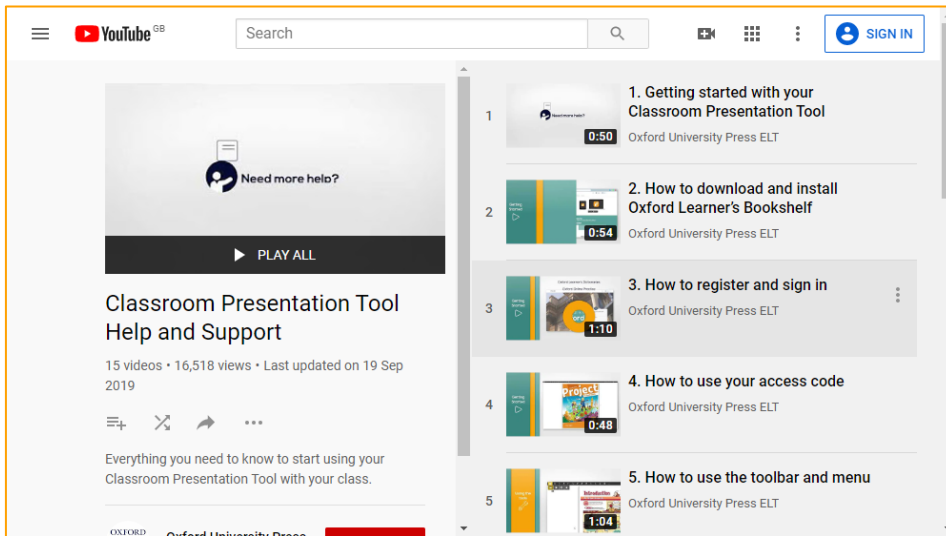

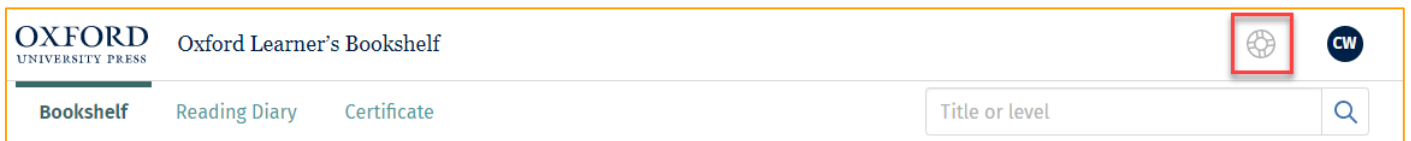
